

Throughout the Tryouts process, an **Offer Folder** is given to those who have been selected.





TEAM PRACTICES

- 2 times per week, 2 hours for all teams.
- A weeknight practice will typically be 6:30-8:30 pm or 7:00-9:00 pm. We will not have practice past 9:00 pm on a weeknight.
- Sunday practice will typically be 12 noon-2:00 pm or 1:00-3:00 pm. We will not have practice past 5:00 pm on Sunday (no Saturday practices).

Practices start in November 2025 after tryouts, depending on the team.

Practice schedules for each team will be announced via email following the week of final team selections.





TOURNAMENT PLAYING TIME

Equal playing time is NOT guaranteed. Playing time is earned.

Longstanding Policy:

We do not discuss playing time with parents/families. This discussion is only between player, coaches and team.

You are paying for the service of quality training, not playing time.

DUES PAYMENTS

An initial Tuition Fee (non-refundable) is due upon acceptance of an offer during tryout dates. Your junior club tuition and monthly dues pay for the following as it relates to your Kingtide team's expenses (National Qualifiers and National Championship Tournament team fee, food, hotels and airfare expenses for out-of-town travel is <u>not</u> included):

- Tournament Entry Fees (local friendship, regional friendship and CEVA Power League)
- Gym Rental for Practices
- Uniform Package (already included as part of the total dues)
- Coach Monthly Stipend
- Coach Travel Expenses
- Volleyball Equipment
- Administrative Fees and Professional Services
- Office, Misc. Expenses

Payments paid through our online system. Auto-payments are on the first day of each month. The 5th of the month incurs \$25 late fee. There is also an option to pay your season in full.

We are here to support families in need of assistance to pay their club dues through fundraisers and monthly payment plans (November 2025 to April 2026).
